



## HEAL Initiative Fellow Role Description

**Position Title:** Ob/Gyn HEAL Fellow

Tuba City Regional Health Care Corporation is a 73 bed hospital serving the Western side of the Navajo Nation and the Hopi village of Moenkopi. Clinical specialties include Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, Anesthesia, OB/GYN, General Surgery, Orthopedics, Optometry, Ophthalmology, ENT, Radiology, Pediatrics, Mental Health, Neurology, Dermatology, Rheumatology, Nephrology, Emergency Medicine and a newly opened Oncology center.

**Department:** Ob/Gyn

The clinical staff of the Ob/gyn department currently includes 6 full time physician positions when fully staffed.

**Position Description:** The position is approximately 80% Outpatient and 20% Inpatient Care. Rotating HEAL Fellows will have both continuity and new patients in the outpatient setting, including both obstetric and gynecologic patients. They will be able to identify patients with surgical needs, take them to the operating room and follow them post-operatively. When on call, they will follow the inpatient gynecologic patients, antepartum and post-operative obstetric patients and co-manage the moderate and high risk obstetric patients on the service with the midwifery provider. They will serve as a consultant to outside facilities such as Hopi Health Center and Kayenta Health Center. They will be the consultants for the Tuba City Emergency Department for Ob or Gyn patients. Fellows will be assigned departmental duties and asked to serve on committees to represent the department. They are encouraged to participate in quality improvement projects and attend meetings of their interest. If fellows have interest/time outside clinical duties, they are also welcome to do outreach to the community or coach local sports such as soccer or T-Ball/Little League. Fellows can take on leadership roles, in particular QI projects, if they have interest/time outside of clinical duties. Current projects include working with the EHR, asthma, mortality, and readmissions.

Fellows will also be involved with teaching the medical students and residents who rotate here.

**Job Requirements:** By 1 July 2021 applicants must have completed residency training at a US-based residency program. Applicants must be able to provide highly competent inpatient and outpatient level care and have a clear passion for serving the underserved.
